- a. Improve dissemination of current diabetes guidelines / best practices

The materials provided by Dr. Dake are used to teach residents. Are meant to provide a “distilled” format of standards for monitoring and treatment. Group will review and provide feedback on slides (does material fit with current ADA standards? Are slides alone able to present material with clarity or is additional explanation needed?) through the listserv. Perhaps slides could be used by individual clinicians – made available as teaching material on the web? Lori and other MDCH staff will follow-up on possibility of using the DPAC website to this end.

4. New projects

- b. Implementation of a diabetes registry

Dr. Dake shared information on the implementation of a diabetes registry (May 2010). Noted that the biggest challenge was resources needed to key in the data and maintain records (he is fortunate to have a grant-funded position).
